George E. Wintrode, 87, of Andrews, passed away at 10:51 pm Sunday, March 30, 2025, at his residence.

George was born on February 3, 1938, in Wabash, IN, the son of Robert Wintrode and Nola (Alexander) Wintrode. He graduated from Lagro High School with the class of 1956. George married Brenda on October 24, 1989, in Las Vegas, NV. George was a past member of the Huntington Moose Lodge 837 and Andrews Lions Club.
