Georgiana M. Crockett, age 92, of Huntington, died at 8:50 a.m. Sunday, June 26, 2016 at Heritage of Huntington.

Visitation will be from 10 a.m. - 12 p.m. Friday, July 1, 2016 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington. Funeral services will immediately follow at 12 p.m. Friday at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Rev. Bill Rapp officiating. Burial will be in Gardens of Memory in Huntington County with military graveside rites performed by VFW Post #2689 of Huntington.

Georgiana was born on November 25, 1923 in Huntington, the daughter of Paul and Hazel (Brubaker) Mitchell. She graduated from Port Jervis High School in New Jersey in 1941. She served in the United States Navy during World War II and married Hartford B. Crockett in June 1944; he preceded her in death on December 17, 1983. Georgiana was a self-employed pedicurist in Huntington for 25 years. She also worked in sales for Brown and Rowe and for Milford Dress Shop. She was a member of Central Christian Church in Huntington and the Huntington County Art Guild.

Survivors include a son - Bill (Shelley) Crockett of Roanoke, three

granddaughters - Melissa (Lonnie) Williams of Fort Wayne and Amy (Ryan) Fields and Cassandra (Kurt) Land, of both of Roanoke, and ten great grandchildren. She is preceded in death by her parents, husband, a son, Thomas Crockett, and three brothers, Kenny Mitchell, David Mitchell, and Bill Mitchell.

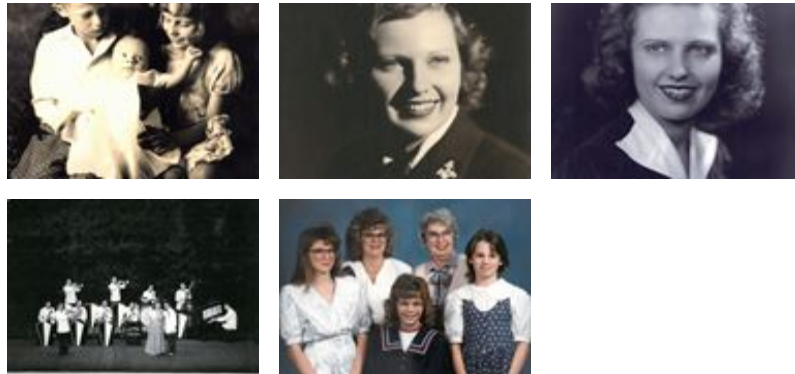
