Gerald Eugene Landrum, 72, of North Manchester, passed away peacefully at 8:12 am Friday, April 7, 2023, at his home.

Gerald was born on June 29, 1950, in Indianapolis, IN, the son of Dean Landrum and Beulah (Colclessner) Landrum. He graduated from Manchester High School with the class of 1969 and enlisted into the US Army National Guard.
