



Glen D. Gooley

March 30, 1929 - September 6, 2018

Glen D. Gooley, age 89, of Huntington, died at 12:45 p.m. Thursday, September 6, 2018 at Oakbrook Village in Huntington.

Visitation will be from 3 – 7 p.m. Monday, September 10, 2018 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Tuesday, September 11, 2018 at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Pastor Chris Hayden officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the service. Burial will be in Mt. Hope Cemetery in Huntington.

Glen was born on March 30, 1929 in Huntington, the son of Charles W. and Maisie (Ormsby) Gooley. He worked as a paperboy in the 1940s, counting change on the marble rail in the courthouse, at the Double Dip, with his father in construction, and he farmed 167 acres, all before entering the United States Marine Corps. While in the Marines, he completed the Riggers Course at Camp LeJeune and became a Corporal during the Korean War. He married Janice Lorraine Krile on December 23, 1952 in Burbank, California; she preceded him in death on May 17, 2000 after 47 years of marriage. After his discharge from the military, the couple returned to Huntington where he was a

master craftsman, designing and building his own home. Glen worked at Lehman Floor Covering in Huntington with his brother-in-law Carl and his sister Audrey. Glen was the youngest of eight children and dearly loved all his siblings Chuck Gooley, Mary Lancaster, Lorren Gooley, Robert Gooley, Gene Gooley, and baby Donald Ray Gooley who left this world at eight days old. Glen took loving care of his parents. His nieces, nephews, cousins, aunts, uncles, and grandparents all meant the world to him. Throughout his life, he was was a member of American Legion Post #7, Color Guard, Huntington Moose, 40 & 8. More than anything, he loved being a husband, father, grandfather, and great grandfather. He enjoyed people, lunches with friends at Johnny's, his John Deer tractor, nature, and telling stories with precise details. His memory was truly amazing as he was able to recall the temperature on a given day in 1937 or the measurements and style of carpet, tile, or linoleum in a home he worked in 40 years ago. Glen treasured his education and remembered the names of all his teachers. He was known for many baked goodies and loved cooking for his family; even after his first stroke, he was home in two days making cookies for Christmas and baking a ham at 6:00 a.m. He always made sure no neighborhood children were hungry and often made homemade hot chocolate and served many ice skaters in the winter. He was the most devoted husband, father, family member, friend, St. Louis Cardinals fan, and Chicago Cubs fan. Those who knew him knew he had his own way of doing things, and until his last moment on earth, he did just with dignity, humor, laughter, gratitude, and love, and a lot of directions. His legacy will live on.

Survivors include a son, Timothy D. (Donna) Gooley of Huntington, daughters Tamra (Steven) Caley and Cynthia K. (Jimmy) Emley, both of Huntington and Joni (Jimy) Utley of North Carolina, 11 grandchildren, 21 great grandchildren, and honorary family members, Connie Sams, Cindy Scheiber, Jennie LaLonde, Rebel Hensley, Leanna Arello, and Loretta Przybylinski. He is preceded in death by his parents, wife, and seven siblings.

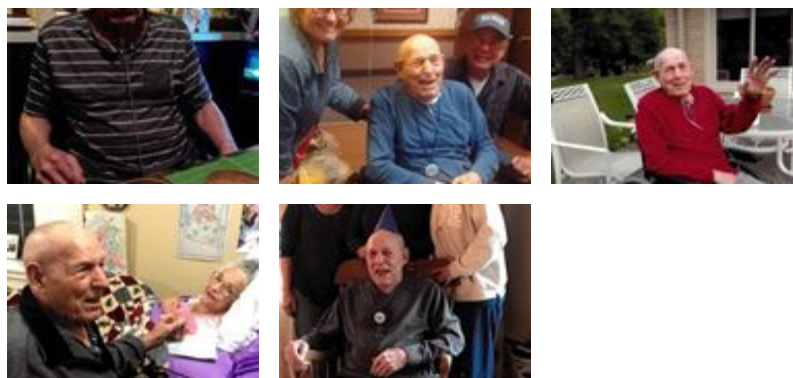

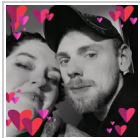
