



## Gloria A. Rupley

December 29, 1933 - March 8, 2017

Gloria A. Rupley, age 83, of Huntington, died at 7:10 a.m. Wednesday, March 8, 2017 at Visiting Nurse and Hospice Home in Fort Wayne.

Gloria was born on December 29, 1933 in Huntington County, the daughter of Norbert and Mildred (Pfister) Johnson. She graduated from Clear Creek High School in 1951 and married Max A. Rupley on August 7, 1954 in Huntington. Gloria retired from Helvey and Associates in Huntington after 35 years of service. She was a lifelong member of Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Huntington, where she was active in the choir and Rosary Sodality, and was a Eucharistic minister.

She is survived by her husband of 62 years - Max A. Rupley of Huntington; three sons - Timothy A. (Diana) Rupley of Fort Wayne, Kevin J. (Barbara) Rupley of Huntington, and Brian E. (Renee) Rupley of Greenfield; a daughter - Sue E. (William) Scheiber of Huntington; a brother - Donald (Jean) Johnson of Huntington; 17 grandchildren, and 13 great grandchildren. Her parents and a sister, Helen Ness, precede her in death.
