Gregg A. Poe, 76, of Andrews, passed away at 3:00 am Saturday, November 25, 2023 at his residence.

Gregg was born on November 21, 1947 in Huntington, IN, the son of Lewis Poe and Mary (Whitacre) Poe. He graduated from Huntington Township High School with the Class of 1966. Gregg was a proud Veteran of the United States Navy, serving during the Vietnam Conflict from 1966 to 1969. He was a Life Member of the NRA and he enjoyed fishing and hunting.
