H. Maxine Stetzel, formerly of 1824 E. State St., Huntington, Indiana passed away on September 13, 2022 at the age of 104. She had been a resident of the Heritage of Huntington since November 2001.

She and Brice moved to the Heritage in 2001 where she obtained a sewing room to continue her hobby with fellow residents and continued to hold an

Annual Bazaar until age 95. She finished her last quilt at age 97.
