



## Harold F. Huebner

April 5, 1921 - January 1, 2014

Harold F. Huebner, age 92, of Huntington, died at 12:55 p.m. Wednesday (January 1, 2014) at his home.

Family will receive friends from 3 p.m. - 7 p.m. Tuesday (January 7, 2014) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Wednesday (January 8, 2014) at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Pastor Todd Thomas officiating. Burial will be held in Star of Hope Cemetery in Huntington County with military graveside rites performed by VFW Post #2689.

Harold was born April 5, 1921 in Engadine, Michigan, the son of Frank and Bertha (Bentz) Huebner. He graduated from Engadine High School in Michigan in 1941. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II as a surgical technician in England. He married Lura Jean Dennis on June 23, 1946 in Huntington. She preceded him in death in September of 1957. He married Esther Lucille Yeager in May of 1959 in Syracuse. She preceded him in death on February 3, 1982. He retired from Fisher Body in Marion in 1980 after 23 years in welding. He was a member of VFW Post #2689 in Huntington and also a member of UAW Local 977.

Harold is survived by one stepson - Jay Haney of Roanoke; two daughters - Jan (Richard) Mish of Schererville and Joan (Ray) Morris of Huntington; two stepdaughters - Cheryl (Mike) Thomas of Markle and Vicki (Kim) Johnson of Huntington; 12 grandchildren, 21 great-grandchildren, and eight great-great grandchildren. His parents, his wives, and one son - Jay W. Huebner, precede him in death.
