July 14, 1920 - January 11, 2016

Harold E. Pulley, age 95, of Bippus, died at 9:45 a.m. Monday (January 11, 2016) at Tipton Place in Huntington.

Visitation will be from 3 - 7 p.m. Friday (January 15, 2016) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday (January 16, 2016) at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Dave Gradeless officiating. Burial will be in Mt. Etna Cemetery in Huntington County.

He retired in 1991 after 25 years as a self-employed carpenter for Pulley's Construction. He worked at Memcor for 28 years as a supervisor. He was a 32-year volunteer on the Bippus Fire Department. He was a member of St. John's United Church of Christ in Bippus and a member of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows.

Survivors include his wife of 70 years - Mary Anna Pulley of Bippus; a son - Robert H. (Jeanette) Pulley of Laramie, Wyoming; three daughters - Barbara Ann Pulley of Andrews, Brenda Sue Mount of Huntington, and Betty (Bobby) Andrews of Cookville, Tennessee; two brothers - Charles Pulley and Ronald Pulley, both of Columbia City; a sister - Norma Lahr of Phoenix, Arizona; 11 grandchildren, 20 great grandchildren, and a great-great granddaughter. He is preceded in death by his parents, a daughter - Becky Jo Pulley, a sister - Jennie Weber, and three brothers - Homer Pulley, Howard Pulley, and Clarence Pulley.

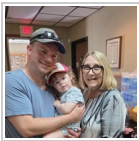
