Henry Edwin "Eddie" DeHaven, age 60, of Huntington, died at 4:30 p.m. Saturday (October 10, 2015) at Markle Heath and Rehabilitation.

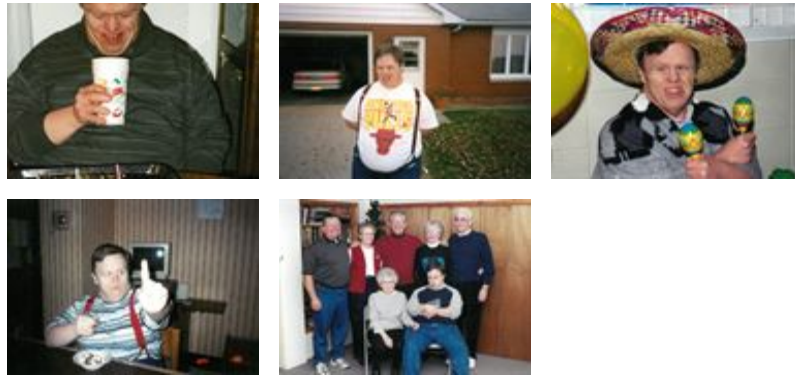
