



Henry S. "Hank" Hanson Jr.

January 15, 1925 - August 12, 2011

Henry S. "Hank" Hanson, Jr., 86, of Huntington, died at 8:10 PM Friday (August 12, 2011) at the Parkview Huntington Hospital.

Hank was born on Jan. 15, 1925 in Spring Hill, Alabama to Henry Selmer Hanson, Sr. & Louise (Grooms) Hanson. Henry was a PFC for the Army during WWII serving at the Battle of the Bulge. He married Vivian Irene (Wright) Hanson on July 15, 1947 in Ft. Wayne, IN. Vivian preceded him in death on April 10, 2011.

Hank retired as a Terminal Manager for Yellow Transit in Ft. Wayne, was past owner of Hank's Disposal Service for 17 years, and an Operations Manager & Bus Driver for Landmark Charter Bus. He also served as Town Marshal for Roanoke and was a Reserve Officer for the Huntington County Sheriff's Department. Hank belonged to the VFW Post #2689, American Legion Post #7, Eastern Star of Huntington, Free Mason Shriners of North America & Shriners International, 50 year member of the Grand Lodge F.&A.M. of Indiana, was an honorary member of the Chief LaFontaine Saddle Club, and a member of the Sweetwater Assembly of God in North Manchester, IN.

He is survived by one son - Terry (Katy) Hanson of Greenfield, OH; one daughter - Daralene (Dick) Bowman of Huntington; grandchildren - Shantiel Fulton of Huntington, Bart & Heather Hanson of Greenfield, OH, Aaraka &

Tommy Case of Lagro, IN, Racquel & Nate Mills of Huntington, Danielle & Chris Line of Huntington, Andrea & Brandon Haselby of Monticello, IN, and Ashley & Peter DeLaney of Charlotte, NC. His parents, wife, an infant sister, and a son - Darvin Eugene Hanson preceded him in death.
