May 29, 1921 - November 6, 2009

Hessie Ann Garner, age 88, Markle, died at 10:20 p.m. Friday (November 6, 2009) at Markle Health and Rehabilitation.

Mrs. Garner was a homemaker and loved her grandchildren and great-grandchildren passionately. Hessie was a member of the Grayston Avenue United Brethren Church here in Huntington. She also was involved in the Women's Missionary Society and involved in the Lincoln PTA.

Hessie was born on May 29, 1921 in Decatur, Tennessee, the daughter of Jesse A. & Ada (Bryant) Teague. She married Amos B. Garner in Hernando, Mississippi on December 14, 1946. Amos preceded her in death on November 27, 2002.

Survivors include one daughter – Susan Richard of Huntington; two sons – Don (Angie) Garner of Huntington and Dave (Rhonda) Garner of Auburn, IN; one sister – Lessie Willis of Newbern, TN; ten grandchildren and twenty-one great-grandchildren. Her parents, husband, four sisters, five brothers, and a grandson – Heith Garner preceded her in death.

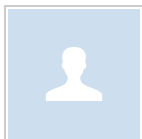
