Holly Diane Sale, age 60, of Huntington, died at 5:11 a.m. Friday, June 30, 2017 at Parkview Regional Hospital in Fort Wayne.

Visitation will be from 2 - 8 p.m. Wednesday, July 5, 2017 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral Services will be held at 11 a.m. Thursday, July 6, 2017 at Salamonie Church of the Brethren, 2662 West 600 South, Huntington, with Dr. Sherilyn Emberton officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the service. Private burial will be at a later time.

Holly was born on July 12, 1956 in Logansport, the daughter of James T. and Claire L. (Mars) Connolly. She graduated from Winamac Community High School in 1974; she attended Purdue University for two years and graduated from Indiana University School of Medicine in 1978 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Physical Therapy. She and Mark Sale were married on September 3, 1983 in Winamac. In 1989, Holly earned a Master of Health Science degree

in Physical Therapy from the University of Indianapolis. She started her physical therapy career at Huntington Memorial Hospital in June of 1978, which is now Parkview Huntington Hospital, recently completing 39 years. She started as a staff physical therapist, then as Director of Rehabilitation Services, and currently was Director of Rehabilitation and Wellness, Physicians Specialty Clinic, and Service Excellence/Patient Experience for the past several years. Holly had a passion for the patient experience and service excellence, and a special interest in health and wellness and providing for the health care needs of the community.

Holly was an active member of Salamonie Church of the Brethren, where she served as choir director, as she loved music and singing. She completed Huntington County Leadership Academy class in 2000. She was currently serving as President of the Huntington County Safety Council, Secretary for the Parkview Huntington Boys and Girls Club, President of Huntington University Foundation, Huntington University Board of Trustees, board member with Pathfinder Services, and past board member of United Way and Red Cross. During her membership in Tri Kappa, Chi Chapter of Huntington, she held many offices including Past President. Holly loved watching basketball and football, and was an avid Huntington University and Purdue fan. She enjoyed exercising, reading, and knitting. She loved spending time with family and friends, and loved traveling to the mountains or walking on the beach. She dearly loved her "Marcus Welby." Romans 8:28 and Psalm 46, were Scriptures she lived by, and gave her comfort.

Survivors include her husband of 33 years, Mark Sale of Huntington, a sister, Vicki (Jon) Canfield of Fort Wayne, and a brother, Dane (Lori) Connolly of Omaha, Nebraska. Also surviving are her mother-in-law, Lela Sale of Huntington, five nieces, and two nephews. Her parents and her father-in-law, Robert Sale, precede her in death.

In the midst of this deep sadness there are thoughts of Holly that make me smile and even chuckle. Her enthusiasm for life and energy are what most of her family and friends will remember. There are "Hollyisms" that will always linger with me. She was known to say "Now let me make sure I completely understand this...." or " looking at the big picture.....". She loved " the BIG picture".

One of the most fun times in all our careers was an event that took place in the very early days of Parkview Health embracing the service excellence concept. I believe it was in the late 1990s that the rehab leaders from all the Parkview hospitals decided that the best way to introduce excellence in customer service was with a long skit to our therapy teams. The comfort I find in this tragedy is Holly's unwavering faith. I know that she is safe and happy in the eternal home that has been prepared for her.

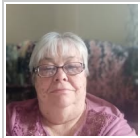
