November 27, 1922 - February 28, 2022

Ireta Rahn, widow of the late Richard Rahn passed away on Monday, February 28, 2022, at Heritage Pointe of Huntington where she has resided since December 28, 2015.

She was born in Roanoke, IN to Everett & Mellie Farrell on November 27, 1922. She married Richard H. Rahn December 31, 1942, in Denver CO. He died January 20, 2001. They were married 58 years.

Her parents and a brother Ronald Farrell preceded her in death.

working in the gift shop.

She was a 81-year member of Evangelical United Methodist Church where she taught the youth group and Sunday school. Also, a 75-year member of Floral Chapter #75 OES (now Columbia City Chapter #65) where she also served as Worthy Matron.
