



Jack W. Kirkpatrick

September 14, 1935 - April 4, 2016

Jack W. Kirkpatrick, age 80, of Huntington, died at 3:53 a.m. on Monday (April 4, 2016) at Visiting Nurse and Hospice Home in Fort Wayne.

Visitation will be from 3 - 7 p.m. Friday (April 8, 2016) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday (April 9, 2016) at Bailey-Love Mortuary. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the service. 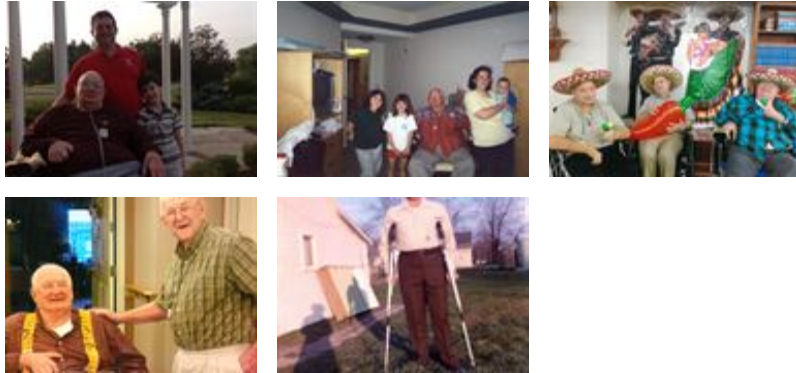

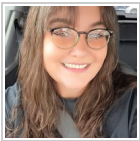
