James W. Broxon, age 83, of Huntington, passed at 5:40 a.m. Friday (December 23, 2011) at his home.

James was born April 6, 1928, in Huntington, the son of Omer and Clara M. (Thorn) Broxon. He was a veteran of the United States Army serving during WW II. On October 12, 1949, he was united in marriage to Cecile M. Cavinee.

James retired from K-Mart in Fort Wayne after 38 years of service. He also worked for the Erie Department Store and Ace Hardware in Huntington. James was a member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints and a lifetime member of the V.F.W. Post #2689 both in Huntington.

Survivors include his wife of 62 years - Cecile M. 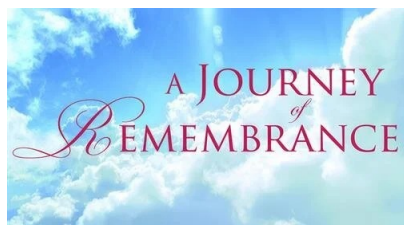

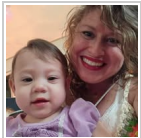
