James W. Craig, age 65, of Huntington, died at 1:32 p.m. Saturday (June 20, 2015) at his home.

Jim was born on December 10, 1949 in Huntington, the son of William and Kathryn (Saunders) Craig. He graduated from Huntington High School in 1967 and studied for a year at Vincennes University. He served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War, earning a Bronze Star, and Vietnam Service and campaign medals. Jim married Donna Flegal on November 14, 1972 in Winchester, Indiana. He farmed with his father for many years and retired from the United States Post Office where he worked for over 30 years as a mail carrier serving Fort Wayne, South Whitley, and Petroleum. He was a

member of Faith Chapel United Methodist Church as well as the American Postal Workers Union #286 in Fort Wayne and American Legion Post #160 in Roanoke.

Survivors include his wife of 42 years - Donna Craig of Huntington; two sons - Michael William (Sara) Craig of Fort Wayne and Todd Aaron (Mindy) Craig of Huntington; one sister - Judy Michel of Huntington; and seven grandchildren - Olivia Craig, Lily Craig, William Craig, Elizabeth Craig, Alana Craig, Kristina Urberg, and Christian Urberg. 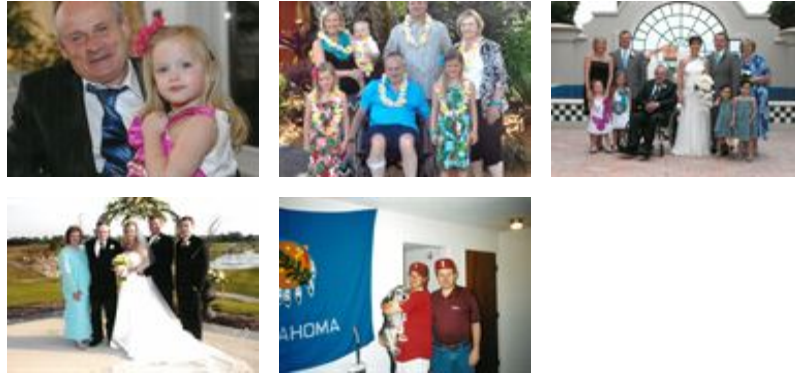
