James E. Smith, age 76, of Huntington, died at 3:00 a.m. Monday (April 27, 2015) at Parkview Regional Medical Center in Fort Wayne.

Visitation will be held from 3 p.m. - 7 p.m. Thursday (April 30, 2015) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be at 10 a.m. Friday (May 1, 2015) at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Pastor Paul Hirschy officiating. Burial will be in Gardens of Memory in Huntington County.

Jim was born on June 25, 1938 in Huntington County, the son of Fred W. and Annetta G. (Bartrom) Smith. He graduated from Bippus High School in 1956 and married Brema J. Altman on June 28, 1959 at Huntington. Jim worked at Schacht Rubber Company for five years, Memcor for 11 years, Curtin Productions for five years, and retired from Hiner Transport as general manager after 27 years. He was a member of Huntington Church of the Brethren, where he was past chairman of Stewards Commission and served on various other committees. He was a member of Huntington Jaycees, in which he held chairmanships at both the state and local level and was Director of the Year in 1970. Jim was Past President of Huntington Lions Club,

Kiwanis Club, Industrial Management Council, South Side Business Association, Big Brothers Big Sisters, Huntington County Rural Sewer District, and Bel Air Association. He also served on United Way and as a member of both FOP and Indiana Motor Truck Association. He was a member of Moose Lodge #837 in Huntington. He participated in YMCA Indian Guides and was a board member on Huntington County Baseball for many years. He coached Kim League, Pony League, and Little League for 18 years. Jim was an avid golfer, and it could possibly be said that he was the biggest IU fan in Huntington County.

Survivors include his wife of 55 years - Brema J. Smith of Huntington; two sons - Parke E. (Beth Ann) Smith of Leesburg and Price A. (Connie) Smith of Huntington; one brother - Jon W. (Christine) Smith of Fort Wayne; two sisters - Peggy Stahl and Jean (Don) Johnson, both of Huntington; five grandchildren - Nathan Moore, Nicole (Jason) Lang, Alan (Erin) Moore, Desiree Hartwig, and Tristan Criss; and eight great grandchildren - Harrison Moore, Emmelin Moore, Cooper Moore, Kate Moore, Ryan Lang, Pippa Lang, Dayton Hartwig, and Zara Chiocchio. He is preceded in death by his parents and one brother - Jan A. Smith.

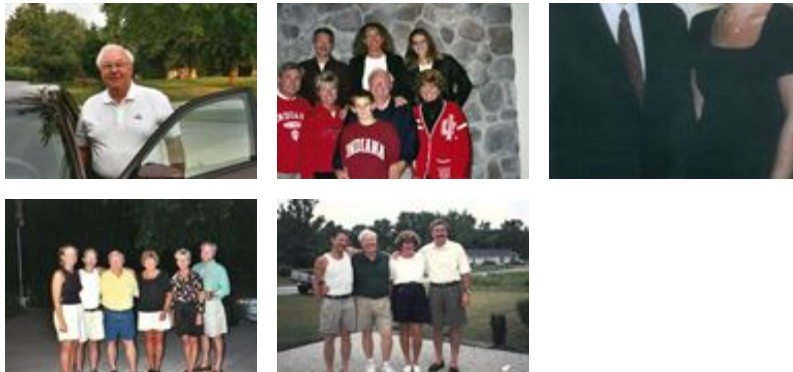
