



James Frederick "Fred" Young

May 9, 1921 - July 31, 2012

James Frederick "Fred" Young, age 91, of Huntington, passed at 11:00 a.m. Tuesday (July 31, 2012) at the Tipton House in Huntington, Indiana.

"Fred" was born May 9, 1921 in Huntington, the son of William Marion and Gladys (Farley) Young. He graduated in 1939 from Huntington High School before entering the military. He was Sergeant of the United States Army and served in World War II receiving three bronze stars. "Fred" married Ruth Eloise Stands on August 7, 1943 in New Orleans, Louisiana.

"Fred" owned Kent's Shoe Store in Frankfort, Indiana for 39 years and retired in 1988. He was a member of Central Christian Church and the V.F.W Post # 2689 in Huntington.

Survivors include his wife of 69 years - Ruth Eloise Young of Huntington; daughter - Sally (David) Marlin of Greensboro, North Carolina; son - James William (Jane) Young of Cameron Park, California; five grandchildren and fourteen great grandchildren. His parents, brother - William Young, Jr.; five sisters - Mary Herndon, Roberta Hartle, Helen Holzinger, Esther Hower and Marjorie Hunsinger preceded him in death.
