



## Jane Branham

August 2, 1912 - April 9, 2012

Jane Branham, age 99, of Huntington, died at 11:10 p.m. Monday (April 9, 2012) at The Heritage of Huntington. She was a resident of Crawfordsville for 41 years and in November of 1978 she moved to Huntington.

Jane was born on August 2, 1912, in Crawfordsville, Indiana, to Elpha B. and Mae Ida (Cole) Grisell. She was a 1930 graduate of Crawfordsville High School. She later attended the Indiana Business College in Indianapolis. Jane married Forest Faye Branham on June 6, 1937 in Crawfordsville. They had 45 years of marriage before he preceded her in death in September of 1982.

Jane retired in 1976 from the Crawfordsville Electric Power and Light Company where she worked for over 15 years as the Head Cashier. She was a member of College Park United Brethren Church in Huntington.

Survivors include a son - John F. (Kathy) Branham of Huntington; a daughter - Martha Jane Branham of Woodside, New York; five grandchildren - Kathy (John) Arthur of St. Petersburg, Florida, Christina (Wayne) Wheeler of Mountain Green, Utah, Shelly Weedman of Madisonville, Louisiana, Amy (Rod) Richison of Huntington, Joanna (Brent) McGill of Carmel, Indiana; and nine great-grandchildren. Her parents, husband, brother - Addison Grisell and sister - Martha Gallear preceded her in death.

Visitation will be held from 3 - 7 p.m. on Thursday (April 12, 2012) at Bailey-Love Mortuary. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Friday (April 13, 2012) at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Rev.
