Jason M. Verellen, age 32, of New Haven, passed away at 5:11 p.m. Friday, June 22, 2018 at St. Joseph Hospital in Fort Wayne from complications of a heart attack.

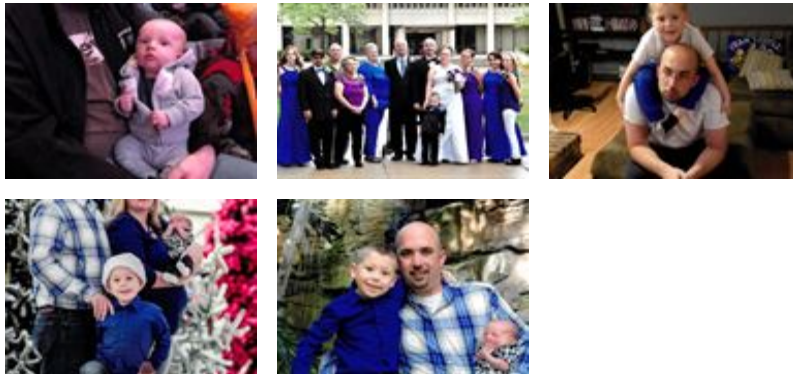
