Jean E. Tallman Florent, age 83, of Huntington, died at 7:25 a.m. Monday (December 29, 2014) at her home.

Jean was born on October 26, 1931 in Huntington, the daughter of Lloyd D. and Daisy (Clinger) Young. She graduated from Huntington High School in 1949, and she was an Honorary Queen of Job's Daughters. She married William R. Tallman on January 7, 1951 in Huntington. He preceded her in death on January 3, 1990. Jean worked for Triad-Utrad and Public Service of Indiana. She was a member of the Order of Eastern Star, Floral Chapter #75 in Huntington. She married William Florent on November 2, 1992 in Huntington. She retired in 1994 from the Huntington County Community School Corporation. She participated in Women's Fellowship at First United Church of Christ in Huntington and was a strong supporter of Huntington North High School athletics and IU basketball. She dearly loved her Cavalier King Charles Spaniel, Charlie.

Jean is survived by her husband of 22 years - William Florent of Huntington; her son - Thomas (Suzette) Tallman of Huntington; her stepdaughter - Beverly (Rev. 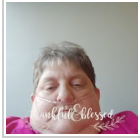
