Jeanette E. Schilling, age 88, of Huntington, died at 4:50 p.m. Saturday (January 2, 2016) at Visiting Nurse and Hospice Home in Fort Wayne.

Visitation will be held from 4 - 7 p.m. Friday (January 8, 2016) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 10:30 a.m. Saturday (January 9, 2016) at Evangelical United Methodist Church, 1000 Flaxmill Road, Huntington, with Rev. Dr. Marti Lundy officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the service. Burial will be in Pilgrims Rest Cemetery in Huntington.

Jeanette was born on August 19, 1927 in Jackson Township in Huntington County, the daughter of J. Ross and Hazel A. (Smith) Rice. She graduated from Roanoke High School in 1945. She married Arden L. Schilling on March 23, 1947 in Roanoke. Jeanette retired from Square D in Huntington in 1989 after 15 years in quality control. She was a 50-year member of Evangelical United Methodist Church in Huntington and a member of United Methodist Women, in which she also served as Treasurer. She was a member of the Order of the Eastern Star Floral Chapter #75 and a 50-year member of Forever Friends. She volunteered for at the Forks of the Wabash and

Parkview Hospital. She also delivered meals to the homebound.

Survivors include her husband 68 years - Arden Schilling of North Manchester; three daughters - Janice (Wayne) Merriman of Hendersonville, North Carolina, Patricia (Marc) Gruber of Fernandina Beach, Florida, and Sara (Matthew) Wilcox of Andrews; seven grandchildren, and one great grandchild. She is preceded in death by her parents, a brother - Ned Rice, and a sister - Mary Margaret Rice.

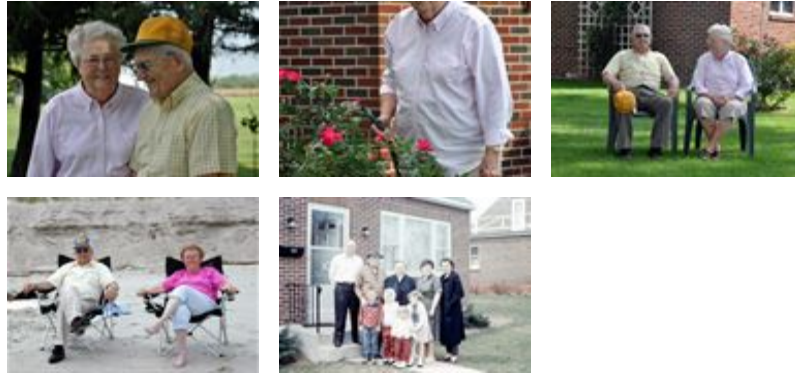
