



Jeffrey L. Stoffel

October 24, 1955 - July 3, 2011

Jeffrey L. Stoffel, age 55, of Huntington, passed on Sunday (July 3, 2011) at 11:30 p.m. in Roanoke.

Jeff was born October 24, 1955, in Huntington, the son of Thomas and Margaret "Peg" (Rudig) Stoffel. He graduated from Huntington High School in 1974. Jeff was a veteran of the United States Army serving in Vietnam and held the rank of SPC-E4.

Jeff was employed as a machine repairman with Dana Corporation in Marion for 33 years. He was a member of SS. Peter and Paul Catholic Church, V.F.W. Post #2689 and Dana Corporation Local Union #7113. Jeff loved to sky dive and was a base jumper. He was one of four Huntington residents to jump the New River Gorge Bridge, West Virginia. He also loved to play guitar, ride his motorcycle, run, swim and be outdoors.

Survivors include his parents - Thomas and Margaret "Peg" Stoffel of Huntington; two sons - Jeremiah L. (Danielle L.) Stoffel of Huntington and Jaryd L. (Cierra T.) Stoffel of Huntington; one daughter - Heather L.
