



Jesse Bill Fordyce

March 24, 1953 - May 25, 2024

Jesse Bill Fordyce, 71, of Marion, passed away at 4:24 pm Saturday, May 25, 2024, at Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne, IN.

Jesse was born on March 24, 1953, in Würzburg, Germany, the son of Robert Fordyce and Velma (Foughty) Fordyce. He graduated from Huntington North High School with the class of 1972. Jesse proudly enlisted in the United States Army in 1975 and served for 3 years as a Drill Sergeant in Fort Hood, TX. He worked at Wynn's for 15 years as a sales representative and was awarded Salesmen of the Year. Prior to then, he worked at GM in Marion, IN, for 11 years. Jesse was the past owner of The Hoosier Drive-In, and the Sitting Bull Coffee Shop. While living in Florida, he owned North Port Small Engine Repair. Jesse loved racing cars and did so for 28 years and was inducted into the Kokomo Legends.

Once Jesse traded his Camaro for a day for two hardtail choppers and went to Ft Wayne all day cruising, by the time we got back I couldn't hardly walk my back hurt so bad. Jesse always had something to do but you didn't always do what you planned! I was Jesse best man in his first wedding and made memories until he went into the Army, then we lost touch untill years later when my health declined and I had to retire. We started going out with Jesse and Cathy and always had a good time. Even when we moved to Borden, Jesse and Cathy would come and visit, always looked forward to their visits. Last six months Jesse bought 4 or 5 race cars, and everytime he brought one he call and want me to drive it. I'd say Jesse, I'm 71, I'm to old to race! When he bought the rail dragster he had me pick up skinny weenie front wheels for it in Louisville. The day before he passed away he called and wanted to know when We were going to bring the wheels up and if I wanted to race the rail I said Jesse I'm 71 years old, he said that alright it's easier now, there is a button to push when the light turns green and it just goes, just hold it in a straight line. I said how fast will it go, he 240, I said that's pretty fast! How'd you stop it, he said don't worry it's got a parachute but he never said it had a button or what, guess it doesn't matter if you're 71? Jesse said do you want to drive it, I said sure what can go wrong? He said when can you bring the wheels up, I said Friday, but I didn't make it. So sorry Jesse We're sure going to miss you, until we meet again in that race track in Heaven, I'll bring your skinny weenie wheels with me when I come!
