Jesse W. Herrick, age 92, of Huntington, passed at 6:48 p.m. Monday (December 12, 2011) at Lutheran Hospital in Ft. Wayne.

Jesse was born April 23, 1919, in Huntington, the son of Emil and Viola (Hoppe) Herrick but was raised by his grandparents, Jesse and Elizabeth Minton. He graduated from Huntington Township High School in 1937. On June 8, 1940, he was united in marriage to Freida L. Hoover in Huntington. She preceded him in death on February 13, 1996.

Jesse retired from Majestic Company after 18 years of service as a supply clerk. Prior to that, he was employed with Schacht Rubber Company for 21 years. He attended Huntington Baptist Church.
