Joan R. Kloer, age 72, of Andrews, died at 6:45 p.m. Saturday (August 21, 2010) at The Heritage of Huntington.

Joan was born in Fort Wayne on October 27, 1937, the daughter of Carl E. and Mary Garneta (Diss) Altman. She graduated from Elmhurst High School, Fort Wayne, in 1955. Joan married Paul F. Kloer on April 21, 1956 in Fort Wayne at the Trinity English Lutheran Church.

Joan was a homemaker and owner of the Kloer Villa Herb Shop in Andrews. She was a member of the Calvary Chapel Assembly of God Church in Wabash. Joan was a devoted and loving wife, mother and grandmother.
