John W. Bischoff, 73, of Fort Wayne, passed away at 11:20am Wednesday morning, September 24, 2025, at Lutheran Life Villages of Pine Valley in Fort Wayne.

John was born the son of Paul and Austa Mae (Riggers) Bischoff on March 11, 1952, in Huntington, IN. He graduated from Huntington North High School with the Class of 1970. After high school, John started work in the printing industry at Our Sunday Visitor in Huntington and became a journeyman cutter. Through the years he worked for several other printing companies including R. R. Donnelly, Renaissance, and EP Graphics. He was a member of St. Peter Lutheran Church in Huntington, IN.

had the heart of a big teddy bear. John enjoyed seeing family and loved his nieces, nephews, great nieces and nephews and hearing about them, seeing their pictures and videos.
