John C. Halsey, 74, of Huntington, tragically passed away at 1:32 pm Monday, July 10, 2023, at Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne, IN.

John was born on July 21, 1948, in Huntington, IN, the son of Charles Halsey and Dorothybelle (Pasko) Halsey. He graduated from Huntington High School with the class of 1967 and drafted into the United States Army. He served during the Vietnam War as a dog handler. He married Kathie Snowden on June 5, 1970, and they shared 44 years of marriage before she preceded him in death on August 8, 2014. John was blessed to find love again and married Janette Sturgeon on August 5, 2018, in Huntington, IN. He worked for Mohr Construction of Kokomo, IN, for 7 years before joining the team at E&B Paving where he retired after 20 years of service.
