John Gilbert Hoch, 69, of Huntington, passed away peacefully with his family by his side on November 20, 2023, at Heritage Pointe of Huntington after a long illness.

He was born on February 28, 1954, to Max and Mary (Saluke) Hoch of Huntington. John was a 1972 graduate of Huntington North High School. He worked as a Manufacturing Engineer at Wayne Metals in Markle, IN, and at Wiley Metal Fabricating Services in Marion, IN, until he retired in 2013. He married the love of his life, Sharon Kay Platt of Huntington County, Indiana on June 2, 1979, at St. Peter's First Community Church. He was a lifelong resident of Huntington County and grew up attending Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church, later joining the Church of Christ.

In junior high school John formed a band with his best friends and they performed together through young adulthood. But most of all, John loved his family. He is survived by his wife, Sharon Hoch

of Huntington, IN; two daughters, Sarah (David) Baty of Indianapolis, IN and Danielle (Joe) Shape of Roanoke, IN. He is also survived by two sisters, Kathy (Robert) Chwedyk of Algonquin, IL, and Jane (John Edward) Hohe of Huntington, IN; and a brother, Max Joseph (Linda) Hoch of Roanoke, IN.
