Joseph L. Holloway, age 88, of Huntington, saw the light and took his step into Heaven at 9:20 a.m. Sunday, January 27, 2019 at Oakbrook Village in Huntington.

Visitation will be from 3 – 7 p.m. Thursday, January 31, 2019 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Friday, February 1, 2019 at College Park United Brethren Church, 1945 College Avenue, Huntington, with Pastor Gary Dilley officiating. There will be one hour of visitation at the church prior to the service. Burial will be in Gardens of Memory in Huntington County with military graveside rites performed by VFW Post #2689 of Huntington.

1997. He was a member of College Park United Brethren Church in Huntington and was an avid bowler with the Seniors of Huntington. He and his wife loved traveling and camping.

Survivors include his wife of almost 70 years, Marjorie H. Holloway of Huntington, daughters Marilyn K. Ratliff of Huntington and Patricia A. 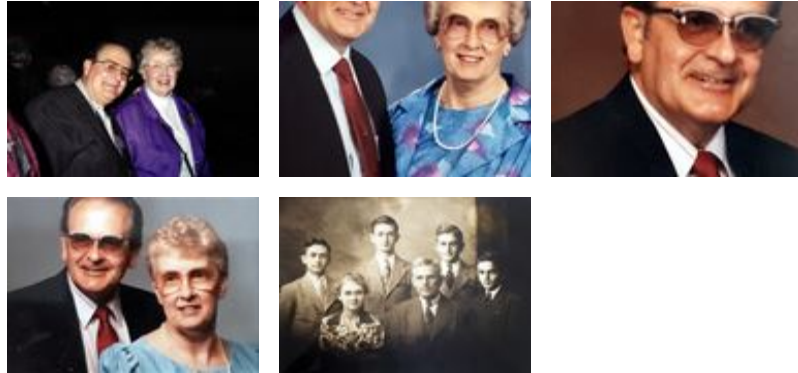
