



Joseph S. Ness

May 20, 1932 - June 12, 2015

Joseph S. Ness, age 83, of Huntington, passed away at 10:29 a.m. Friday (June 12, 2015) at his home.

Visitation will be held from 2 p.m. - 8 p.m. Tuesday (June 16, 2015) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10 a.m. Wednesday (June 17, 2015) at SS Peter and Paul Catholic Church, 860 Cherry Street, Huntington, Indiana, with Father Ron Rieder officiating. Burial will be in Mount Calvary Cemetery in Huntington with military graveside rites performed by VFW Post #2689 of Huntington.

Joe was born on May 20, 1932 in Huntington, the son of George A. and Mary (Palmer) Ness. He graduated from Roanoke High School in 1950 and married Patricia M. Christman on February 14, 1953 in Huntington. He served in the United States Army as an M.P and thereafter earned a degree in Accounting from International Business College. Joe started his career in auctioneering in 1950 and received his real estate brokerage license in June of 1961. Joe was the founder and former owner of Joe Ness Real Estate and Auctioneer, also known as Ness Bros., which was established in 1963 in Huntington. He was a

member of the State and National Auctioneers Associations, and the State and National Realtors Associations. Many members of our community remember Joe's charisma best by his witty response to the routinely asked question "How are you today"? Joe would always reply..."Well, I'm better than I was (then he would pause), but not as good as I was, before I got worse". Many generations of 4-H members might recall hearing his fast-talking auction chants throughout the fairgrounds. Joe always donated his services to many local organizations, such as the Huntington County 4-H Club and the Roanoke Fall Festival, until he retired in 2007. He was a devoted member of SS Peter and Paul Catholic Church of Huntington and often auctioneered the Fall Festival held each year at the church.

Survivors include his wife of 62 years - Patricia M. Ness of Huntington; two sons - Kurt J. (Carolyn) Ness of Fort Wayne and Erik J. (Judy) Ness of Warsaw; three daughters - Lisa M. Ness and Jill E. Slagel, both of Huntington and Holli C. Ness of Elkhart; four brothers - Palmer Ness, Carl Ness, and Steve Ness, all of Huntington and George Ness of Clearwater, Florida; one sister - Mary Ann Ness of Huntington; 17 grandchildren, and six great grandchildren. His parents precede him in death.
