Juanita Alma Burkholder Buzzard, 93, of Huntington, passed away at 3:35 pm Sunday, November 30, 2025, at Parkview Huntington Hospital.

Juanita was born on August 7, 1932, in York County, PA, the daughter of Melvin Burkholder and Edith (Holtry) Burkholder. She married the love of her life, Roger J. Buzzard, on April 5, 1953, in Huntington, IN, at College Park Church; he preceded her in death on December 15, 2013.

Juanita was a lifelong member of College Park Church, where she sang in the choir and was a Sunday School teacher. Her faith was an important part of her life. She graduated from Huntington University in 1967 with a degree in Education and a Masters in Reading from IPFW. She was awarded a Danforth Scholarship based on scholastic ability and leadership skills. Juanita taught First Grade at Horace Mann School in Huntington County for 27 years before she retired.

She was involved in the Indiana Teachers Association and the Retired Teachers Association. She was President and member of Huntington County Library Board. Juanita was also involved in Altrusa Club, Shakespeare Club, numerous other Book Clubs, and Monday Club. She also enjoyed working with Huntington County Council on Aging and the Red Cross.

When she wasn't busy with all the clubs and organizations she was involved with, she loved spending time painting, reading, playing the piano, singing, crocheting, and gardening. Most of all, her grandchildren were a delight in her life.
