Juanita June Winters, age 90, of Huntington, passed away at 4:25 p.m. Tuesday (February 18, 2014) at Heritage Pointe in Warren.

Family will receive friends 10 a.m. - 12 p.m. Monday (February 24, 2014) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington. Funeral services will be held at 12:00 p.m. Monday at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Bruce Winters officiating. Burial will be held in Gardens of Memory in Huntington County.

Juanita was born on February 12, 1924 in Muncie, daughter of Earl and Nellie Marie (Gibson) Oliver. She graduated from Alexandria High School in 1942, and earned a B.A. from Huntington College in 1966. She completed her M.A. at Northwestern University in 1971. She was the Director of Christian Education for the United Methodist Churches in Columbia City and in Findlay, Ohio for 8½ years. She then worked at College Park United Brethren Church in Huntington for 5½ years, retiring January 1988.

Juanita is survived by her daughter - Barbara Lee Middleton of Indianapolis; three sons - Ted William (Towana) Winters of Huntington, Tim (Lynn) Winters of Warren, and Tom (Glenna) Winters of Mt. 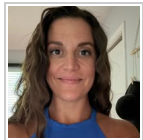
