Katherine "Katie" Amick, age 76, of Huntington, died at 5:00 a.m. Monday (April 11, 2011) at her home.

Katie was born on August 10, 1934, in Wabash, the daughter of Robert P. and Vera (Johnson) Kinerk. She was a 1952 graduate of Wabash High School. Katie went on to attend Indiana University in Bloomington, and graduated from Saint Frances College in Fort Wayne. On September 12, 1954, she married Jack Alan Amick in Wabash and he survives.

Katie retired from Pathfinder Services in Huntington after 25 years of service. Prior to that she was the bookkeeper for Amick Welding Works in Huntington and a homemaker. She was a member of the Central Christian Church in Huntington, the Delta, Delta, Delta Sorority and the Delta Theta Tau Sorority. Katie loved to play Bridge and attend Purdue University sporting events.

Survivors include her husband of 56 years - Jack Amick of Huntington; three sons - Alan (Ellen) Amick of Roanoke, Gary (Deb) Amick of Fort Wayne, and Kevin (Ellie) Amick of Huntington; one daughter - Kathy (Frank) Fife of Salem, Ohio; six grandchildren - Andy Amick, Chris Amick, Mark Amick, John Amick, Jill Zorger, and Katie Fife; and two great grandchildren - Aaron and Austin Amick. She is preceded in death by her parents and brother - Robert L. Kinerk.
