Keith Kaiser, age 81, of Huntington, died at 7:57 a.m. Thursday (April 2, 2015) at his home.

Visitation will be held from 10 a.m. - 12 p.m. Saturday (April 4, 2015) at St. Peter Evangelical Lutheran Church, 648 North Lafontaine Street, Huntington. Funeral services will immediately follow at 12:00 p.m. Saturday with Pastor Tim Anderson officiating. Burial will be in Pilgrims Rest Cemetery in Huntington.

Keith was born on February 28, 1934 in Millard, Nebraska, the son of Arthur and Virginia (Elseman) Kaiser. He graduated from Millard High School in 1951 and attended the University of Wisconsin for two years. He married Ann "Shirley" Bickel on October 2, 1954 in Omaha, Nebraska. Keith worked as a quality control manager at Sealtest in Huntington and was a member of St. Peter Evangelical Lutheran Church, also in Huntington. He loved to attend auctions.

Survivors include his wife of 60 years - Ann S. "Shirley" Kaiser of Huntington; three sons - Keenan S. (Sharon) Kaiser, Kyle (Nickie) Kaiser, and Keith

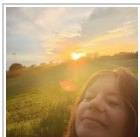
