Kelly J. Cook, age 48, of Huntington, died at 8:50 a.m. Wednesday (March 23, 2016) at Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne, Indiana.

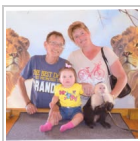
