Kenneth Max Harris, 74, of Huntington, passed away peacefully at his home surrounded family at 4:45 pm Monday, December 7, 2020.

Kenneth was born on June 22, 1946 in Newark, OH the son of Max Harris and Ruth (Lawrence) Harris. He graduated from Huntington Township High School in 1964. Kenneth attended Ball State University for two years, then he proudly served in the United States Navy as a Seabee from May 4, 1966 - August 27, 1969. He married Beverly K. Bullock on February 17, 1973 in Indianapolis, IN. Kenneth retired from the Huntington County Community School System in 2015 where he worked in Maintenance, and previously worked at Shuttleworth as an Engineering Operator. He loved Volleyball, had five awesome girls and five awesome son in laws, enjoyed the outdoors, camping, getting together around the campfire, playing euchre and scrabble, enjoyed auctions and antiques, and also loved being with family and friends and watching the Chicago Cubs play baseball.

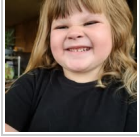
