



Kenneth Cleo Salter

May 13, 1913 - June 6, 2010

Kenneth Cleo Salter, age 97, of Huntington, died at 6:25 a.m. Sunday (June 6, 2010) at the Oakbrook Village in Huntington.

Kenneth was born on May 13, 1913, in Zanesville, the son of Grover C. and Mabel Maxine (Baber) Salter. He was a veteran of the United States Army serving with the 165th Battalion Anti-Aircraft Division of Fort Douglas, Utah. In 1935, he married Ruth Maxine Myers in Huntington and she preceded him in death in August of 2006.

Kenneth was employed as a pipe fitter and plumber for more than 50 years retiring in 1980. He was a member of the Plumber, Steam Fitter & Pipe Fitters Union # 166 for 63 years and also a member of the American Legion #7 in Huntington. Kenneth was a former resident of Warsaw.
