



## Kenneth W. Manes

September 8, 1933 - March 24, 2009

Kenneth W. Manes, age 75, of Huntington, Indiana, died 8:38 a.m. Tuesday (March 24, 2009) at the home.

Mr. Manes was retired from the United States Post Office, as a supervisor, after 47 years of service. He then worked as a Circulation Manager for the Herald - Press until 1983. Kenny was a member of Ss. Peter and Paul Catholic Church, Optimist Club and served on the board of the Habitat for Humanity.
