Kim Kevin "Skinny" Johnson, age 59, of Huntington, died at 6:05 a.m. Tuesday (September 9, 2014) at Summit City Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Fort Wayne.

A gathering of family and friends will be held from 4 - 5 p.m. Sunday (September 14, 2014) at Bethel Assembly of God Church, 1604 Taylor Street, Huntington, Indiana. A memorial service will immediately follow at 5 p.m. Sunday (September 14, 2014) with Todd Thomas officiating. Burial will be in Star of Hope Cemetery in Huntington County.

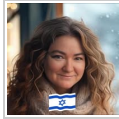
