L. Lamoine DeHaven, age 77, of Warren, died at 12:10 a.m. Saturday (April 26, 2014) at Heritage Pointe in Warren.

Visitation will be held from 10 a.m. - 2 p.m. Wednesday (April 30, 2014), with funeral services immediately following at 2 p.m. at Solid Rock United Methodist Church, 485 Bennett Drive in Warren, with Pastor Kathy Newton officiating. Burial will be in Lancaster Cemetery in Huntington County with military graveside rites performed by VFW Post #2689 of Huntington.
