Lavonne E. Haines, age 92, of Huntington, died at 6:40 a.m. Wednesday, December 21, 2016 at Heritage of Huntington.

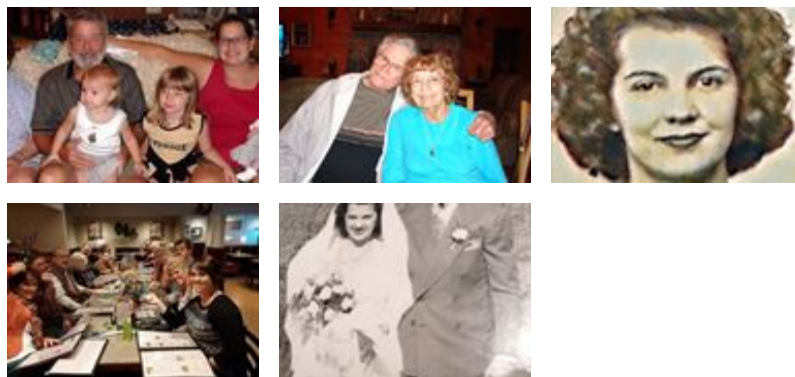
