Lee Anne (Vollmar) Brock, 66, was called home to the Lord at 3:57pm on May 24, 2026, in Ft. Wayne, IN.

She was the smiling face of the Huntington Dairy Queen for 46 years and served as the bookkeeper there until retiring in 2022. Her love of cooking and social nature lead to a successful stint as a Pampered Chef Consultant for 5 years. Lee Anne was an excellent self-taught crocheter who made countless heirloom quality Afghans over her lifetime. She was known to crochet and donate wheelchair shawls and lap blankets for the elderly and hats for cancer patients. Her kindness and generosity were infectious and will be truly missed by all who knew her.

She was born December 28, 1959, in Smyrna, TN, to the late Donald and Charlotte Vollmar. Being the daughter of a military dad, Lee Anne grew up on various Air Force bases across the US and foreign countries including Germany and Okinawa, Japan. She graduated from Huntington North High School in 1977. Lee Anne was preceded in death by her husband of 34 years, Michael W. Brock.
