



Leo P. Haneline, Jr.

September 5, 1939 - October 18, 2014

Leo P. Haneline, Jr., age 75, of Indianapolis, died at 6:00 a.m. Saturday (October 18, 2014) at his home.

Visitation will be held from 3 p.m. - 7 p.m. Wednesday (October 22, 2014) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Thursday (October 23, 2014) at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Rev. Raymond Scribner officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the funeral service. Burial will be in Beech Grove Cemetery in Huntington County.

Leo was born September 5, 1939 in Huntington County, the son of Leo P. Sr. and Daisy Mae (Harrell) Haneline. He graduated from Noble Township High School in 1957 and attended Ivy Tech in Fort Wayne. He served in the United States Marine Corps with a tour in Okinawa, Japan. He married Sandra E. Black on July 28, 1963 in Wabash; she survives. Leo worked at Essex Company in Columbia City for ten years and also worked at Poly Hi-Solidur in Fort Wayne.

Leo is survived by his wife of 51 years - Sandra E. Haneline of Indianapolis;

two daughters - Dr. Laura Haneline and Melanie Haneline, RPH, both of Indianapolis; his son - Daniel (Sarah) Haneline, FSA, of Loveland, Ohio; three brothers - Robert Haneline of Wabash, Ronald Haneline of Huntington, and Alan Haneline of Columbia City; and 3 grandchildren - Austin Haneline and Courtney Haneline of Loveland, Ohio, and Benjamin Haneline of Indianapolis. He is preceded in death by his parents and an infant brother, Dickie Lee Haneline.

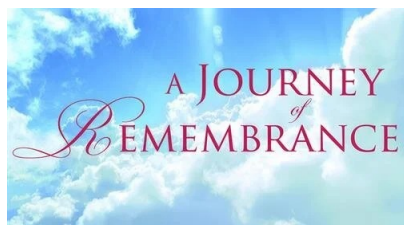

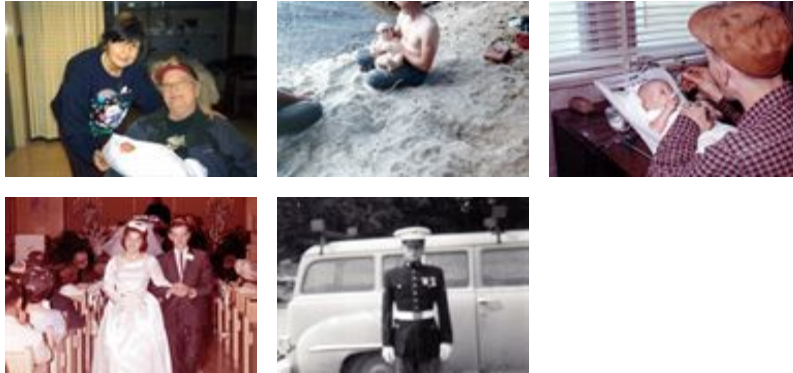
