



## Lewis A. "Lewie" Johnston

March 6, 1919 - October 27, 2011

Lewis A. "Lewie" Johnston, 92, of Huntington, died at 11:42 p.m. Thursday (October 27, 2011) at his home.

Lewie was born March 6, 1919, in Delaware, Ohio, to Lewis A. and Mirium (Hull) Johnston. He was a veteran with the United States Army during WW II as a Sergeant serving in the Burma Theater. Lewie married Betty J. Endsley on June 3, 1961 in Huntington.

Lewie retired in 1976 as owner of Johnston Construction from 1946-1976. He was a lifetime member of the V.F.W. Post #2689, a member of the American Legion Post #7 and New Hope Brethren Church all in Huntington. Lewie loved the lake, boating and the outdoors.

Lewie is survived by his wife of 50 years - Betty J. Johnston of Huntington, one son - Michael (Diana) Nichols of Indianapolis, one daughter - Carolyn Kay Salter of Roanoke, eight grandchildren and several great-grandchildren. His parents and daughter, Donna Jeanne Cozad, preceded him in death.
