L. Louise Rickert, age 95, of Huntington, died at 2:34 p.m. Tuesday (November 8, 2011) at Norwood Health & Rehabilitation in Huntington.

Louise was born August 26, 1916, in Denver, Indiana the daughter of Bert and Gayle (Stowman) Goff. She graduated from Huntington High School in 1934. Louise married Glenn E. Rickert on April 21, 1935 in Huntington.

Mrs. Rickert was a secretary in the Physics Department at Ohio State University and secretary and receptionist for her husband, Dr. G. E. Rickert. 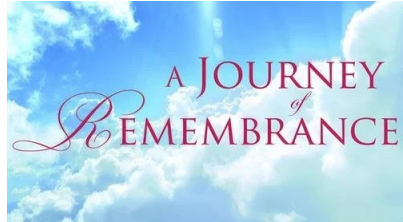
