



Lloyd Earl McDaniel

October 25, 1918 - August 29, 2012

Lloyd E. McDaniel, age 93, of Huntington, passed away at 3:37 p.m. Wednesday (August 29, 2012) at the Heritage of Huntington.

Lloyd was born on October 25, 1918, in Mount Etna the son of Robert Earl and Mamie (Kirkpatrick) McDaniel. He graduated in 1937 from Banquo High School. Lloyd married Catherine "Elizabeth" (Hedrick) McDaniel on October 25, 1938 in Mount Etna. She preceded him in death on June 29, 2005.

Lloyd was a lifetime Wayne and Polk Township farmer. He was a member of Mount Etna United Methodist Church, the Huntington County Farm Bureau Association; he was a member of the Mount Etna's Fire Department for 35 years and the Indiana Fireman Volunteer Fireman Association.

He is survived by a son - Richard (Gerda) McDaniel of Huntington; two daughters - Sallie (Robert) Hartle of Huntington and Barbara Jane (Richard) Straley of Warren; nine grandchildren and sixteen great grandchildren. His parents, wife, two brothers - Glenn McDaniel and Charles McDaniel preceded him in death.
