Lois Lorene Smith Buzzard went to be with her Lord on January 8, 2011. She was 78 years old. She is survived by her husband of 59 years, Donald E. Buzzard of San Antonio, TX; brother James W. Smith of Van Wert, OH; son Ryan E. Buzzard of Mountain Grove, MO; daughter Donis Buzzard Laine of San Antonio, TX; five grandchildren and four great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her sister Eileen Bunker of Huntington, IN. Lois was born November 30, 1932, to parents Charles J. and Ethel N. Smith. Lois graduated from Huntington High School and attended Indiana University where she received several Academic awards. She was a resident of Roanoke, IN for 41 years and for the past 13 years she resided at the family's lake cottage at the Church of God campground on Yellow Creek Lake near Claypool, IN. Recently she moved to San Antonio, Texas. While in Roanoke, Lois was the President of the Roanoke garden club and chairperson of the 1964 Grand Council of the American Indians (which included 29 native tribes). In 1980 she successfully directed the Indiana State Industrial Arts Association conference. Lois was a substitute school teacher for Fort Wayne community schools, a Brownie and Girl Scout leader, and Cub Scout leader. Singing was Lois's passion. She enjoyed singing in the church choir and was requested to perform solos on many occasions. Lois attended the Huntington Church of God and later the Akron Church of God.
