Loma "Jeane" Snoke, 93, of Warren, formerly of Plymouth, IN is now home with her Lord and Savior. Jeane passed away at 4:49 p.m. Sunday, April 14, 2024 at Heritage Pointe of Warren, surrounded by her loving family.

Jeane was born on November 1, 1930 in South Bend, IN, the daughter of Pius A. Kehoe and Goldie (Baker) Kehoe. She married Ross Vernon Snoke, Jr. on September 20, 1953 in Plymouth, IN, after Ross returned from serving in the Korean War. He preceded her in death on October 13, 2023.
